Clothing

- 1 Medium Jacket (it'll be cold when you arrive)
- Comfortable walking shoes
- "Going out" shoes (no cowboy boots or heels, 1-2 inch wedges are fine)
- House Shoes/Slippers
- 2 sets of PJs
- 7-8 Shirts for school
- 1 Professional Outfit for internship
- 2-3 Pairs of shorts (not athletic)
- 2 Pair of jeans
- 2-3 Nice shirts for going out
- Swimsuit
- Undergarments for 10 days
- Workout clothing if wanted
 Popular Ladies Items
- Sundresses, jumpers, skirts
 Popular Men's Items
- Golf tees, golf shorts, casual button ups

School and Extras

- Backpack for class
- PASSPORT
- Water Bottle
- Luggage Tags
- Ear plugs and eye mask for plane
- Neck Pillow
- Wired Headphones for plane
- Vacuum space saver bags or packing-cubes

Electronic & Gadgets

- Headphones
- Outlet Adapters (not converters)
- Phone Charger
- Portable Charger
- Other Device Chargers (watch, iPad, portable charger cable...)
- Camera
- Laptop (WITH CHARGER)

Health

- Prescription Meds IN ORIGINAL CONTAINER. BRING IT IN YOUR CARRY-ON BAG
- Sunscreen
- Hand Sanitizer
- Allergy Medicine (even if you've never had allergies here, pollen is different in Spain)
- Travel Size First-Aid in Carry-on
- Cosmetics

Toiletries

- Toothbrush/Toothpaste
- Hair brush
- Contacts/ Glasses
- Deodorant
- Travel Size Shampoo,
 Conditioner, and Body Wash
- Cosmetics


* DO NOT BRING*

Packing Tips and Tricks for Sevilla

- Checked luggage rules very depending on the airline
- Travel size toiletry items are hard to find in Spain so bring some with you
- You will want a smaller bag for weekend excursions rather than hauling around your large suitcase, think backpack or small duffle
- Put the Education Abroad Sevilla address on your luggage NOT your home address, returning to the US put home address



- You must pack carry-on liquids, gels, etc. in a separate clear bag per passenger.
 None of these items can be more than 3.4oz or 100ml
- Take a toothbrush & toothpaste in carry-on
- Take a change of clothes in your carry-on in case your suitcase is delayed
- Prescription meds and contacts MUST be in carry-on
- Pack your charger and outlet converter in your carry-on!
- Must have debit card and 200 EUROS in cash (in smaller bills)
